

(GoogleDrive) WASHINGTON (CN) – House Democrats have revealed the results of an investigation into President Donald Trump's unfounded claim that President Barack Obama ordered wiretapping of his Trump Tower phones during the 2016 campaign. The House Intelligence Committee report was released Friday morning. Trump claimed that "wiretaps" were placed on his phones at Trump Tower by Obama in an explosive series of tweets on March 4, citing a New York Times report. "Terrible! Just found out that Obama had my 'wires tapped' in Trump Tower just before the victory. Nothing found. This is McCarthyism!" Trump tweeted. The tweet was wildly off base, but it prompted a response from then FBI director James Comey, who in March, the House Intelligence Committee's then chairman, Rep. Devin Nunes, asked the Justice Department for evidence. The department refused to provide such evidence. The Justice Department said it didn't have evidence that the president's phones were targeted. Nunes called Comey's response "bizarre," and said that it made it seem as though the FBI was trying to protect the president from embarrassing revelations. "The FBI Director's statement appears to be an attempt to avoid describing conduct that falls outside the ordinary course of investigative activities," Nunes said. In the end, Nunes agreed to relinquish his leadership role at the committee and was replaced by Rep. Adam Schiff, a Democrat. Schiff's chairmanship is now the last to be named by Democrats on the committee. On Friday, Schiff said in a statement that the committee found no evidence of Obama-ordered surveillance of Trump Tower, but the report "explicitly" states the committee found "no evidence that any president ever ordered surveillance of any U.S. citizen." "While we found no evidence of surveillance, we did not look in every possible place where it could have existed," the statement says. 82157476af
